

RESOLUTION NO. R-2012-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE RE-APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATE FOR CODE ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE A ONE (1) YEAR LETTER AGREEMENT WITH THE SPECIAL MAGISTRATE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Code requires that the special magistrate be either a retired Florida judge or a member in good standing of the Florida Bar for at least five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, in November of 2009, staff interviewed several potential special magistrates and selected attorney Regine Monestime as the best candidate suited for the needs of the City and appointed her to serve for a one (1) year term as a special magistrate; and

WHEREAS, Regine Monestime has served the one (1) year term to the satisfaction of the City and the City desires to re-appoint attorney Monestime for an additional term; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to re-appoint attorney Monestime as special magistrate for code enforcement proceedings for a one (1) year period with an option to renew for an additional one (1) year term.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:


Section 1. Recitals. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 2. Designation of Special Magistrate. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby designate attorney Regine Monestime as special magistrates for a one (1) year period with an option to renew for an additional one (1) year term.

Section 3. Authority of City Manager and City Attorney. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to execute a letter agreement, in substantially the attached form, with attorney Monestime.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.



RE: RE-APPOINTMENT AS SPECIAL MAGISTRATE

Dear Attorney Monestime:

This correspondence is intended to set forth a letter agreement between the City of North Miami ("City"), a Florida municipal corporation, and attorney Regine Monestime ("Special Magistrate"), an independent contractor, (collectively referred to as "Parties").

The Parties agree as follows:

1. **Appointment of the Special Magistrate:** Pursuant to the City Charter, the City Council appoints Attorney Regine Monestime, as a Special Magistrate, effective January 11, 2012.
2. **Term:** This Agreement is for a term of one (1) year with an option to renew for an additional one (1) year term unless terminated as provided in this Agreement.
3. **Independent Contractor:** The Special Magistrate shall be deemed to be an independent contractor and not an agent or employee of the City. The Special Magistrate shall not attain any rights or benefits under the City's Civil Service or Pension Ordinances nor any rights generally afforded to City's classified or unclassified employees. The Special Magistrate is not entitled to the Florida Workers' Compensation benefits as a City employee.
4. **Compensation:** The Special Magistrate shall be compensated One Hundred Twenty-Five and No Cents (\$125.00) per hour for services, non-inclusive of travel time to and from hearings.
5. **Right of City to Terminate:** The City retains the right to terminate this Agreement, with or without cause, upon thirty (30) days written notice at any time prior to the completion of the above services without penalty. The City shall only be responsible to pay the Special Magistrate for any services actually rendered up to the date of termination.
6. **Notice:** All notices or other communications which shall or may be given pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered by personal service, or by registered mail addressed to the other party at the address indicated or as may be changed from time to time. Such notice shall be deemed given on the day on which personally served, or if by mail, on the date of actual receipt.
