

RESOLUTION NO. R-2012-35

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE, A CHEMICAL COMPOUND REQUIRED FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY'S WATER PLANT, BY PIGGYBACKING THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES PROCUREMENT AWARD UNDER RFP# PSUT-10-01 WITH ALLIED UNIVERSAL CORPORATION, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$132,000.00) PER YEAR, FOR A TWO (2) YEAR PERIOD; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, on October 12, 2010, the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, ("Pembroke Pines"), issued *Request For Proposals – Sodium Hypochlorite PSUT-10-01* ("RFP"), seeking a qualified, insured and experienced contractor to furnish and deliver Sodium Hypochlorite in accordance with the technical specifications, terms and conditions contained in the RFP ("Services"); and

**WHEREAS**, in response to the RFP, Allied Universal Corporation, ("Contractor") submitted a written proposal and was competitively selected as having established the criteria, qualifications, and references most advantageous to Pembroke Pines; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 15, 2010, the City Council of the City of Pembroke Pines approved Contractor's proposal and authorized a two-year award commencing on January 1, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 23, 2007, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami ("City"), adopted Ordinance No. 1244, which authorizes the City Manager to approve the purchase of supplies, goods and/or services from current contracts of other governmental entities ("piggyback"), such as Pembroke Pines; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to piggyback the Pembroke Pines procurement award to expeditiously obtain Services for the City's water plant, while applying the most cost effective means available and without compromising the quality of water utility services; and


**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, have determined that piggybacking the Pembroke Pines procurement award for the provision and delivery of Sodium Hypochlorite at a competitive rate and in accordance with the technical specifications, terms and conditions contained in the RFP, is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of North Miami.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**


**Section 1.** **Authority of City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to purchase Sodium Hypochlorite, a chemical compound required for the operation of the City's water plant, by piggybacking the City of Pembroke Pines procurement award under RFP# PSUT-10-01 with Allied Universal Corporation, at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$132,000.00) per year, for a two (2) year period.

**Section 2.** **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


