

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the Dezer Collection to have a carnival with more than three (3) amusement rides.

BACKGROUND

The Dezer Collection applied for permission from the City of North Miami to have a carnival from March 26 to April 5, 2015, at 1890 NE 146 ST. The North Miami Police Department has reviewed the application and is recommending approval by the City Council with the following conditions:

1. A minimum of two (2) off duty police officers are present during operational hours. This requirement can be adjusted due to crowd or other safety concerns.
2. Staff will be provided to direct and monitor parking.
3. No roadways will be blocked.

WHEREAS, Megerle Shows, LLC, has submitted an application for a Carnival Permit, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," for a carnival event open to the general public consisting of amusement rides, food booths, games, and facilities, to be held from March 26, 2015 through April 5, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the application includes a plan of operation detailing the number and types of amusement rides and games to be provided as required by Section 11-60 of the City of North Miami ("City") Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, additionally, an illustrated plot plan demonstrating the layout of the amusement rides is included in the application for the Carnival Permit; and

WHEREAS, Megerle Shows, LLC, and The Dezer Collection, LLC, will collaborate with the North Miami Police Department to coordinate a plan for the evacuation of all persons from the amusement location area in the event of accident, as well as for the cleaning and restoration of the area at the conclusion of the carnival; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to authorize the issuance of a Carnival Permit allowing for the operation of more than three (3) amusement rides to Megerle Shows, LLC, with the conditions outlined in the attached North Miami Police Department Memorandum, dated March 5, 2015.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Approval and Issuance of Carnival Permit. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby, approve and authorize the issuance of a Carnival



Hi Andrea,

To respond to the questions:

1. There will be 220 parking spots available at the Miami Auto Museum and another 100 on the carnival site itself. Mr. Dezer owns another vacant, fenced lot adjoining the carnival site fenced lot and could, if needed, open that lot for parking. That vacant lot's parking capacity is not considered in the 220 nor the additional 100 spaces. It would be in addition to the 220 + 100 spaces.
2. Hours of Operation: 5PM-11PM Monday-Friday; 1PM-11PM Saturday & Sunday. The Carnival Operators reserve the right to operate, with notice, on Holidays from 11AM-11PM.
3. It is understood and accepted that there will be an off duty police requirement.
4. Private Security can be obtained for the Carnival if deemed appropriate and needed. The Miami Auto Museum employs a private security firm 7 days a week/24 hours a day.

Sec. 11-60. - Amusement rides.


(a) The use of more than three (3) amusement rides is prohibited. For the operation of such rides, professional operators can be employed, provided that they are permitted on the grounds only during the legal hours of operation. The city council may authorize the use of more than three (3) amusement rides where the sponsoring organization presents to the city council a plan of operation setting forth following items:

- (1) The number and type of rides and of games to be provided; *15 rides plus games*
- (2) A plot plan demonstrating the layout of the rides; ✓
- (3) A plan for the evacuation of all persons from the amusement location area in the event of accident; ✓
- (4) The method of cleaning up and restoring the amusement area at the conclusion of the carnival.

(b) The city council shall require that the sponsoring organization post a bond sufficient to assure that the amusement area will be restored to the condition it was in prior to the carnival.

(Code 1958, § 15-2(b)) \$500 Bond for clean-up.

(4) THE METHOD OF CLEANING UP: PHYSICAL PICK-UP OF GARBAGE, LITTER, ETC. Dumpster disposal + removal.
