

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-R-29**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO ATLANTIC MACHINERY, INC., UTILIZING THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROVISION PURSUANT TO SEC. 7-169 OF THE CITY CODE, ON A CONTRACT AWARDED THROUGH THE NATIONAL JOINT POWERS ALLIANCE, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$172,464.50) FOR THE PURCHASE OF A CUES TELEVISION INSPECTION TRUCK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Miami (“City”) desires the purchase of a Cues Television Inspection Truck (“Vehicle”); and

**WHEREAS**, the National Joint Powers Alliance (“NJPA”) is a governmental purchasing cooperative with over fifty thousand (50,000) member agencies which establishes and provides nationally leveraged and competitively solicited purchasing contracts under the guidance of the Uniform Municipal Contracting Law; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 9, 2014, NJPA issued RFP No. 022014 “Sewer Vacuum, Hydro-Excavation and/or Street Sweeper Equipment with Related Accessories and Supplies” seeking responsive and responsible vendors to establish national contracts to provide quality products, equipment and services for fleet needs; and

**WHEREAS**, Atlantic Machinery, Inc. (“Vendor”), was competitively selected by NJPA for the provision of fleet equipment, in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the solicitation; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 7-169 of the City Code authorizes the City to participate in cooperative purchasing agreements for the procurement of supplies or services with one (1) or more public entities; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff requests approval to trade in a surplus 2006 Freightliner Truck toward the purchase of the Vehicle; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 7-169 of the City Code, the City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the City Manager to execute purchase orders for the provision of Services, based on a competitive price to the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1. Authority of City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to issue a purchase order to Atlantic Machinery, Inc., utilizing the cooperative purchasing provision pursuant to Sec. 7-169 of the City Code, on a contract awarded through the National Joint Powers Alliance (“NJPA”), at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$172,464.50) with the trade in of a surplus 2006 Freightliner Truck.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
