


# NE 125th Street Improvements Phase II



In 2010-2011, the City used federal stimulus funds to improve the sidewalks downtown. Now that this "Phase I" is complete we are ready to embark on Phase II, which will include significant enhancements to the downtown North Miami corridor, including:

- Textured, on-street parking
- Quality street furnishings (benches, trash cans, bicycle racks)
- Bulb-outs with landscaping
- Removal of black olive trees
- New trees and planters on the sidewalks
- Textured crosswalks at major intersections



As of July 2011, construction plans are under review at the Florida Department of Transportation, and the project will be bid once permitted. Construction is expected to begin in late summer 2011.

This is only one part of our efforts of transforming downtown North Miami into a pedestrian, transit and bicycle friendly, attractive destination that will foster a successful business environment and a stronger community.
