

TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE PROVIDER REGISTRATION INFORMATION AND APPLICATION SHEET

Chapter 17, Section 17-204 of the Code of Ordinances (the "Code") of the City of North Miami (the "City") requires that any telecommunications service provider (TSP) that desires to erect, construct, install, maintain, repair, expand, or use any telecommunications facilities in; or under, public right-of-way in the City obtains a registration from the City. No public right-of-way construction permits shall be issued to a TSP not registered with the City. A registration shall not convey title, equitable or legal, in the public right-of-way. Registrants may only occupy public rights-of-way for telecommunications facilities. Registration does not excuse a telecommunications service provider from obtaining appropriate access or pole attachment before locating its facilities on another person's facilities. Registration does not excuse a provider from complying with all applicable city ordinances.

To obtain a TSP Registration a person shall apply to the City Manager's Office or any other Department designated by the City Manager, and meet the following requirements:

Insurance Requirements (Sec. 17-211):

The Registrant shall provide, pay for and maintain, throughout the term of its Registration the types of insurance described herein. The limits of coverage of insurance required shall be not less than the following:

- 1. Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) for property damage in any one (I) accident;
- 2. Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) for personal bodily injury to any one (1) person;
- 3. One million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for personal bodily injury in any one (1) accident

Bonding, Surety and Indemnification Requirements:

Upon the submittal of an application for TSP Registration, the Registrant shall file with the City for its approval, an annual bond or corporate guarantee in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) having as a surety a company qualified to do business in the State of Florida, and acceptable to the City Attorney. The bond or guarantee shall be conditioned on the full and faithful performance by the registrant of all requirements, duties and obligations imposed upon Registrant by the provisions of the City's Code of Ordinances. The bond or guarantee shall be furnished as frequently as necessary to provide a continuing guarantee of the Registrant's full and faithful performance at all times. In the event a Registrant fails to perform its duties and obligations imposed upon the Registrant by the provisions of the City's Code, subject to section 17-213, there shall be recoverable, jointly and severally from the principal and surety of the bond, any damages or loss suffered by the City as a result, including the full amount of any compensation, indemnification or cost of removal or abandonment of any property of the registrant, plus a reasonable allowance for attorneys' fees, up to the full amount of the bond. In lieu of the bond or guarantee required by the City's Code, the city may in its reasonable discretion accept a corporate guarantee of the Registrant or it parent company; if the Registrant is a publicly traded company and maintains an insurance rating of no less than A-[1].

Requirements

The registration must comply at all times with all policies, procedures and directives of the City Council, City Manager's Office, Public Works Department, the Community Planning and Development Department and the Building Department.
