

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R-002**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SECOND OPTION TO RENEW AN AGREEMENT, PIGGYBACKING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION AND LYTX, INC., UNDER THE AUTHORIZED FEDERAL SUPPLY INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SCHEDULE PRICELIST - GENERAL PURPOSE COMMERCIAL INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT, SOFTWARE AND SERVICES - SOLICITATION NO. GS-35F-0623S, TO PROVIDE DRIVECAM PROGRAM SERVICES FOR A TERM OF ONE (1) YEAR; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE PURCHASE ORDERS TO LYTX, INC AT AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$35,300.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, on January 10, 2017, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami (“City”), passed and adopted Resolution No. 2017-R-3, authorizing the provision of general purpose commercial information technology equipment, software and services comprising the DriveCam program (collectively referred to herein as “DriveCam Services”) from LYTX, Inc. (“LYTX”); and

**WHEREAS**, the procurement of DriveCam Services was accomplished by piggybacking United States General Services Administration (“GSA”) *General Purpose Commercial Information Technology Equipment, Software and Services - Solicitation No. GS-35F-0623S* (“Solicitation”), in accordance with Section 7-167 of the City Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the provision of DriveCam Services to the City under the Federal Contract was for a term of one (1) year with four (4) additional options to renew in writing, on a year-by-year basis; and

**WHEREAS**, upon completion of the Initial Term, City administration exercised the first option to renew the Agreement with Contractor, with the current renewal term ending on January 9, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, DriveCam Services have been integral in identifying and correcting driver-behaviors resulting in a six percent (6%) decrease in automobile accidents and a sixty-four percent (64%) reduction in costs associated with collisions; and

**WHEREAS**, to avoid any interruption of DriveCam Services, City administration respectfully requests the renewal of DriveCam Services from LYTX for one (1) additional year (“Second Option”); and

**WHEREAS**, LYTX is willing to deliver DriveCam Services to the City at the same favorable terms and rates provided under the Federal Contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of DriveCam Services for the Second Option shall not exceed the annual amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$35,300.00); and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council find the provision of DriveCam Services required by the City in daily operations, serves the public health, safety and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1. Approval of Second Option.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the second option to renew an agreement piggybacking the *General Purpose Commercial Information Technology Equipment, Software and Services - Solicitation No. GS-35F-0623S* with LYTX, Inc., to provide DriveCam Program services for a term of one (1) year.

**Section 2. Authority of City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to issue purchase orders to LYTX, Inc. for the Drive Cam Program services at an annual amount not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$35,300.00).

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
