

ORDINANCE NO. 1125

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA AMENDING THE MEMBERSHIP PROVISIONS OF THE NORTH MIAMI SENIOR CITIZENS' ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami believe that a viable Senior Citizens' Advisory Board will promote and enhance the community; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to amend the membership and requirements for membership of the Senior Citizens' Advisory Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Senior Citizens' Advisory Board membership requirements is amended as follows:

Sec. 2-201. Establishment of board; composition; appointment; term; quorum; officers; removal.

- (a) There is hereby established a senior citizens' advisory board consisting of fifteen (15) seven (7) members, each of whom shall be a resident of the city or who shall have significant ties to the community.
- (b) Each member of the city council shall nominate one (1) three (3) member of the senior citizens' advisory board with two (2) members to be nominated at-large, all of whom who shall be subject to appointment by approval of a majority of the city council. Each member so appointed shall hold office until the second Tuesday in June of the odd-numbered year next following appointment. Members shall hold office until a successor is duly appointed. All terms shall begin and end at noon on the date indicated. The city council shall appoint a qualified person to serve out the unexpired term of any member vacating office by resignation or otherwise.

Section 2. Repeal. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict or which are inconsistent are repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any word, clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect any other word, clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage on second reading by the Mayor and City Council.
